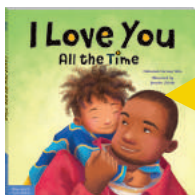

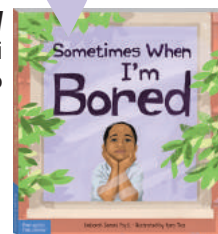

- Kayra Ostendorf at Free Spirit has bought world rights to *Dear Dad: Love, Nelson* by Margaret McBride (I.). A boy's letter to his incarcerated father help them stay connected while they're apart. David Wilkerson will illustrate; publication is scheduled for fall 2023. The author represented herself, and Robbin Brosterman at the Bright Agency represented the illustrator.
